“RAISING THE BAR” AWARD
NOMINATION FORM**

Each year, this award is presented to honor an employee who has made a significant and notable contribution to the advancement of the Mecklenburg County court system. The type of contribution made can vary. It may be related to performance, leadership, innovation, advocacy, public education or some other meritorious area related to the public good. The board of directors will determine the relevancy, level of importance and degree to which each contribution has made a difference. The winner will receive a check for \$1000.00, a plaque in recognition of their accomplishment and the permanent listing of their name in the registry of past winners.

To be eligible, a nominee must be a part-time or full-time employee of the Trial Court Administrator’s Office, Clerk of Superior Court’s Office, District Attorney’s Office, Public Defender’s Office, Magistrate or any other office within the 26th Judicial District, which the board may choose to incorporate upon request. Anyone inside or outside of these organizations can nominate an employee. The information contained within the nomination form will be kept confidential.

A selection committee comprised of members from the Board of Justice Initiatives, Inc. will review the nominations and identify those that are deserving consideration by the full board, which will then select a winner. When writing your nomination, please provide enough information and use specific examples so the selection committee can give their utmost consideration to each nominee.

Please complete and submit the nomination form below by April 1st. The nominations will be reviewed by April 15th and the winner will be announced at the “Evening at the Courthouse” event held at the Mecklenburg County Courthouse.
